

## **NICU Discharge Preparedness Checklist for Preterm Babies**

### **Before Discharge (Hospital Preparation)**

- Have a clear conversation with your neonatologist regarding your baby's discharge plan
- Confirm corrected age with neonatologist
- Check the discharge medications and methods of administration
- Car seat
- Master CPR & choking rescue for preemies (our nurses will retrain you)
- Obtain emergency contacts: Pediatrician, pulmonologist, Ikshana's 24/7 line (+971 50 943 4100)

# **Home Setup Essentials**

- Sanitized nursery with humidity control (40-60%)
- Preemie-safe sleep space: Firm mattress, no loose bedding
- Emergency kit: Bulb syringe, thermometer, saline drops
- Feeding supplies: Breast milk storage containers, Specialized bottles if advised
- + backup formula in case of emergency



#### **First 72 Hours Critical Tasks**

- Know the warning signs (change in the normal pink color, fever, refusal of feeds, fast breathing)
- Feeding journal: Volume, duration, spit-up frequency
- Jaundice check: Morning/evening skin color assessment
- Cord care: Keep it dry and diaper consistently below the navel area
- Urine and stools: frequency and quantity Developmental Milestones (0-12 Months)
- ■1-3 months: Eye tracking, grasp reflex
- 4-6 months: Head control, social smiling
- 7-9 months: Rolling over, babbling
- 10-12 months: Crawling, pincer grasp
- Pro Tip: Our pediatricians use corrected age (not birth age) for milestone tracking!
